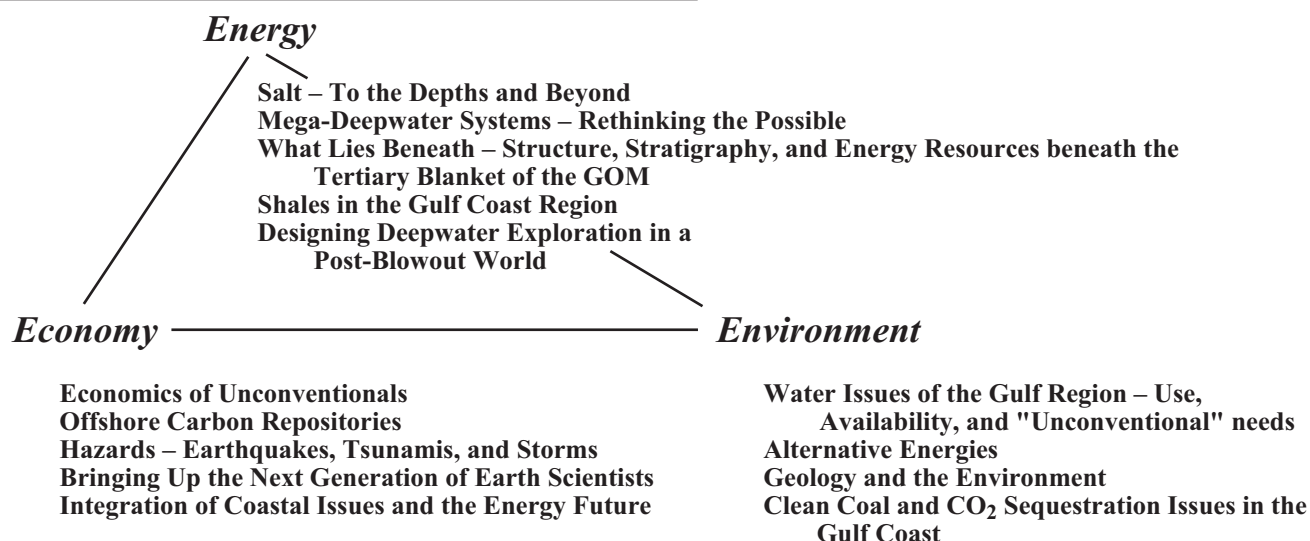

HOW TO SUBMIT...

Abstracts (not more than 250 words) should be submitted for review online or via email to the technical program chair. Papers should have an application to Gulf Coast and Gulf of Mexico Geology. Include your full mailing address, telephone and FAX number, email address, and whether you are submitting for **oral** or **poster** or **either** (preferred).

Submit abstracts by December 2, 2011, as instructed on the website, www.gcags2012.com

Notification of acceptance by January 13, 2012. All presenters, both oral or poster, must submit either a paper (10-12 pages) or an extended abstract with key figures for review by at least 2 reviewers by March 23, 2012, for inclusion in the *Transactions*.
